To put a stallion or mare of Friesian Heritage "On File" send a copy of the pedigree / papers along with the test/s ordered below.

Putting a horse's DNA markers and Genectic Testing "On File" should allow all of their foals to be registered with FHH.

Dwarfism, Hydrocephalus & Distichiasis are inherited genetic deformities that are common (30%) in the Friesian breed. It is important to know, that at this time, KFPS Approved stallions, are allowed to be carriers. Only tests conducted through HH, UC Davis, FHANA / KFPS will be recognized. "NQ tests" from UC Davis can be accepted after a \$15 horse verification fee is paid, to ensure it is the correct horse.

Note: In order to conduct parent verification tests, a \$25 DNA conversion fee may be required for any horses that were not tested through HH. In some cases, a conversion fee(s) may also be required on the sire and/or dam of horse being registered. All hair submitted becomes the property of HH.
